



## Hershey Downtown Redevelopment Project Calls for Parking and Bus Operations Facility



Buchart-Horn, Inc. developed the design for this two-and-a-half-level, single-helix parking structure containing 252 total spaces. The vast majority of these spaces will be used by the occupants of the adjacent, newly renovated Press Building, a historic structure located in Downtown Hershey. To match the historic architectural character, the thin-set brick veneer on the parking structure's spandrel panels was specified to match/compliment the brick on the Press Building facade. Further, ornamental metal railing, light standards and fixtures were also incorporated.



Two elevated pedestrian walkway bridges were provided between the parking structure and the Press Building.

This project precedes the Phase 2 project which involves the design and construction of an adjacent, connected parking structure as part of a new intermodal facility. As such, all facets of the Phase 1 structure were designed to accommodate this addition, including vehicular circulation, pedestrian access, elevator access, foundations, superstructure, and architectural treatments.
